What is the AHA?

Your family doctor is a member of Academisch Huisartsennetwerk AMC (AHA). This is a collaboration between the Academic Medical Centre (AMC) and family doctors in the region.

This way, your family doctor facilitates scientific research and the medical care provided by the family doctor to you, the patient, can be improved.

Scientific research

In the AHA, family doctors work alongside the general medical practice unit of the AMC. The AMC is home to scientific research and your general medical practice provides data for that. It concerns data about the medical care offered to patients. This may include information about the diagnosis, the use of medication, lab results and treatment.

Providing better healthcare together

The AHA ensures that this information is used for scientific research. At times, it is also used to teach medical students and future family doctors. Your family doctor is kept up to date about the results of the scientific research. This means the results can help to improve the healthcare provided at the general medical practice.

Privacy

Academisch Huisartsennetwerk AMC (AHA) devotes a lot of attention to protecting your privacy. It does not collect details such as name, address or citizen service number. This means that the results of scientific research will never show whose medical details were used. If you object to the use of your medical details, you can notify your family doctor. In that case, your details will not be used.
